AUDI, BENTLEY & SKODA	 Audi front - TPH-2 fits if the number plates are screw affixed, and may fit when tape affixed if the tape isn't absolutely edge aligned	X	✓	<p><i>Current Audi's, Bentley and Skoda's have front bumper features into which number plate are tight recessed and flush aligned to edges. If number plates are screw affixed then TPH-2 can be fitted by inserting the recessed number plate tool from the underside and behind the number plate to expose the number plate top edge.</i></p> <p><i>TPH-2 affixes to most Audi, Bentley & Skoda rear number plates (usually with the fixture rotated 180 degrees)</i></p> <p><i>If the front number plate is adhesive tape affixed then TPH-2 installation may be impossible</i></p> <p><i>TPH-2 is incompatible with Audi Q7's 'wavy' grille feature</i></p>
FORD	Mondeo hatchback		TIP	<i>Use TPH-2 rotated 180 degrees - see rear number plate note above</i>
Mazda	2 & 6		TIP	<i>An obstructive front bumper centre styling feature over the number plate can be easily overcome by fitting TPH-2 offset initially and then sliding to centre before 'locking' onto the number plate – this sideways fit method can be useful for other vehicle applications</i>
Wurth Klapp-Fix number plate holder		X	X	<i>TPH-2 is incompatible with Wurth 'Klapp-Fix' number plate frame article # 0825 990</i>
